- Explore occupations associated with any major area of study. Learn about careers associated with all possible majors.

Step 3: Save your favorite occupations and majors with your comments, questions and rankings.

- Review and save 1-2 majors that will support those occupations.

Areas of Study: What education credentials and areas of study are typically pursued by people in this field?
